



NOTICE OF PROTEST HEARING

South Santa Clara County Fire Protection District Annexation 2014

The Local Agency Formation Commission of Santa Clara County (LAFCO) will hold a public hearing to receive protests against the proposed annexation of approximately 38,648 acres of unincorporated lands to the South Santa Clara County Fire Protection District. Annexation would enable the District to have jurisdictional authority to enter into an automatic aid agreement with Santa Cruz County Fire Department for providing fire protection services to the area. The LAFCO Executive Officer will conduct the hearing.

LAFCO approved the annexation proposal on October 1, 2014, as shown in LAFCO Resolution 2014-06. The resolution and map of the annexation area are available for your review at the LAFCO office and on the LAFCO website at: www.santaclaralafco.org/protesthearing.
